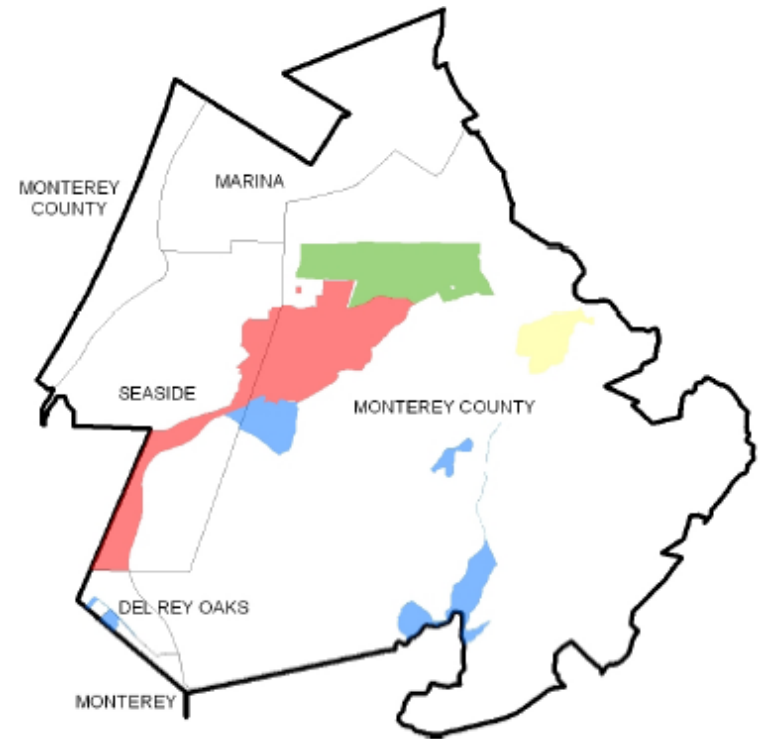

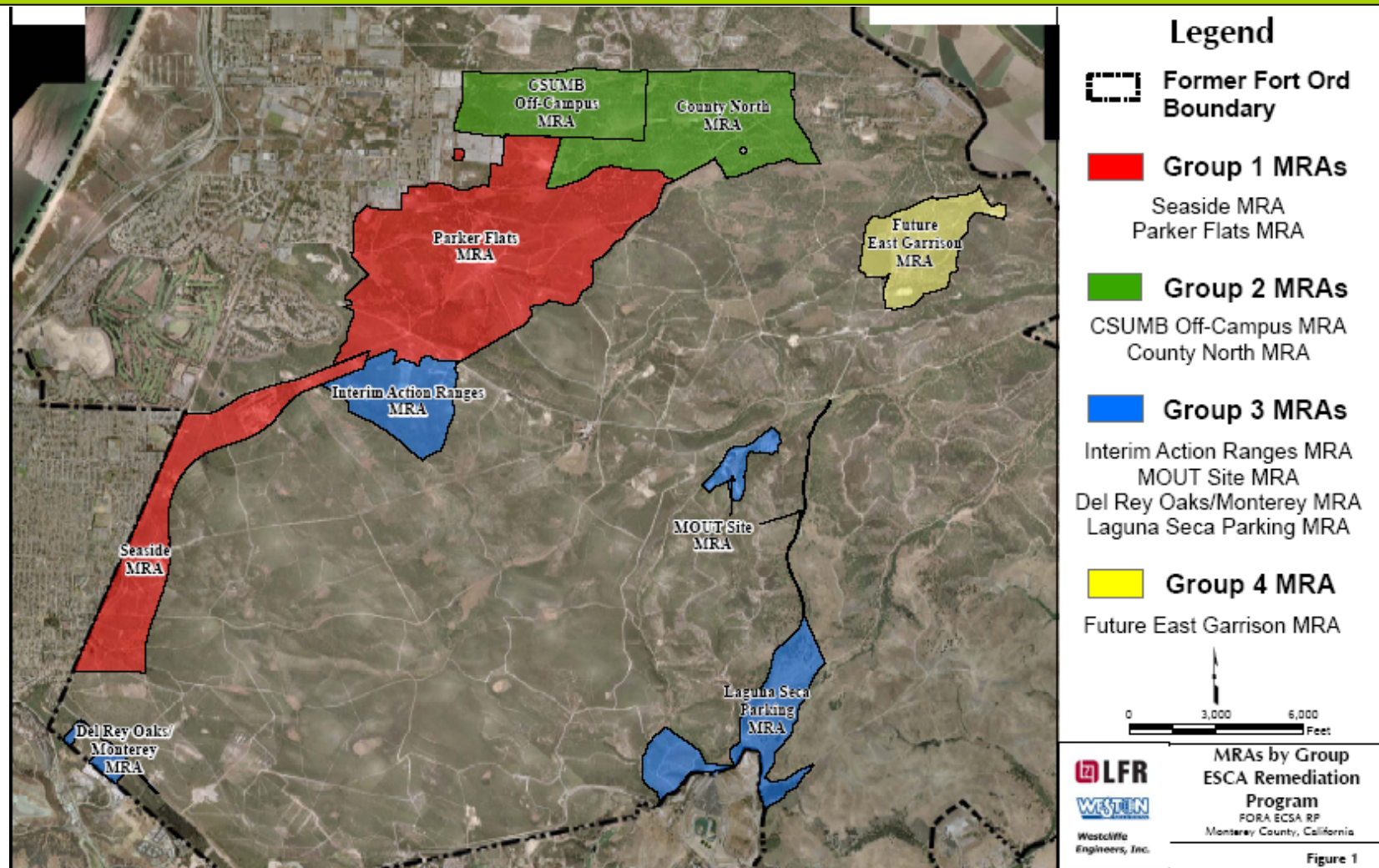

 - Prepared/issued Record of Decision
 - Transferred Cemetery property to FORA
- **FORA:**
 - Prepared/issued Land Use Control Implementation Plan
 - Will transfer Cemetery property to the jurisdictions
- **Jurisdictions:**
 - Will transfer property to the Veterans Cemetery Foundation

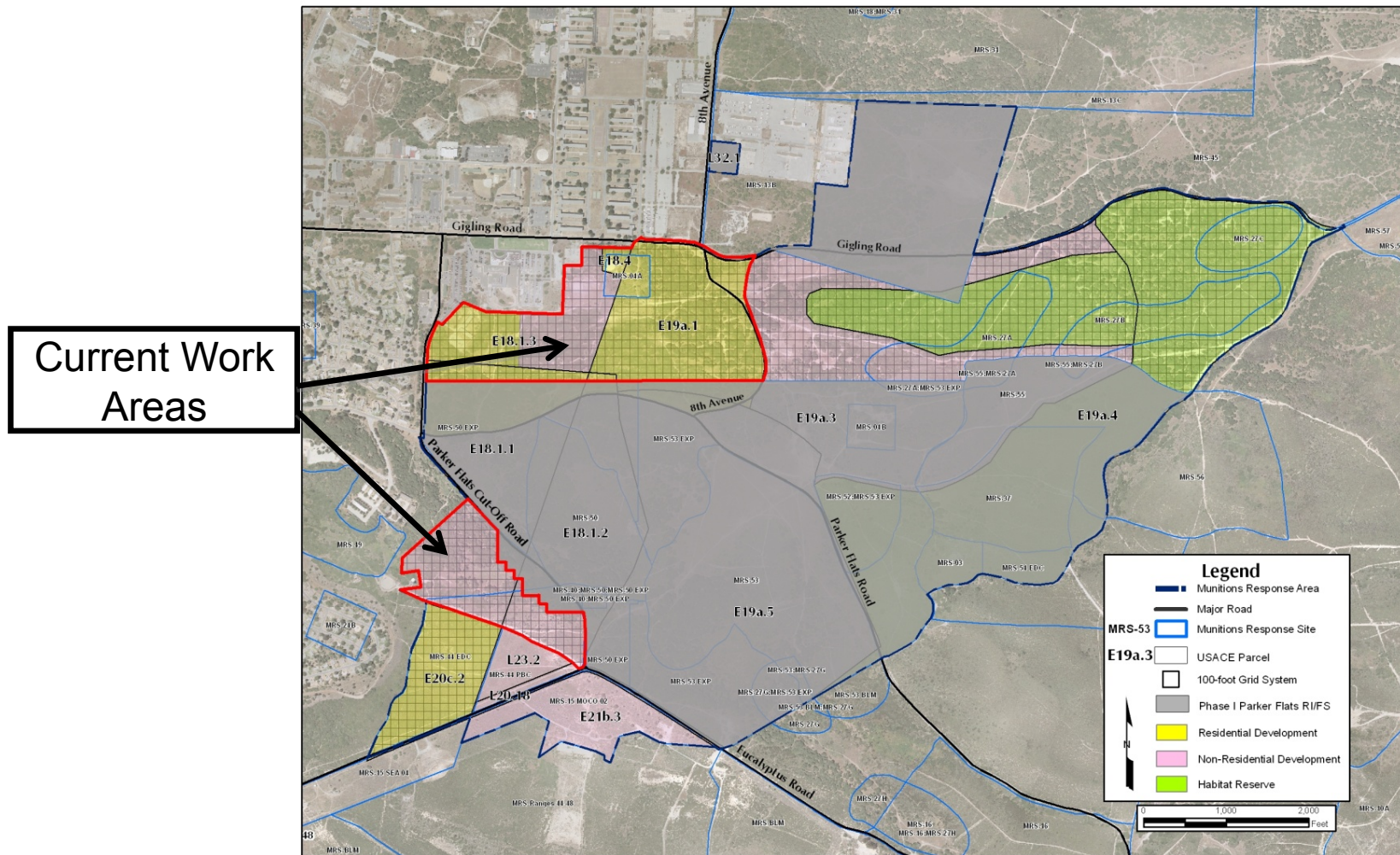

Update: County North Track 1

- **Status:**
 - February 2010:
 - Final Track 1 Plug In Approval Memorandum issued
 - March 2010:
 - EPA & DTSC concurred on Track 1 recommendation
 - Official documents placed in Army Administrative Record
 - Public Notice published Salinas Californian and Monterey Herald
- **Next Steps:**
 1. Install signage defining County North boundary
 2. Prepare for land transfer to County



Overview: Parker Flats MRA



Update: Parker Flats

- Investigation work in western quadrants.
- Technicians have recovered 780 MEC items.
- Finds include:
 - practice grenades
 - smoke and pyrotechnic items
 - projectiles
- Finds are consistent with military training activities.
- Investigation work will continue into early 2011.

- Group 3 properties comprise:
 - Interim Action Ranges MRA
 - Military Operations In Urban Terrain (MOUT) MRA
 - Laguna Seca Parking MRA
 - Del Rey Oaks/Monterey (DRO/Monterey) MRA
- Previous Group 3 investigations & removals by Army
- Additional investigation needed in Interim Action Ranges
- Interim Action Ranges will be separated for investigation
- Rest of Group 3 will continue to be processed concurrently.

Group 4 MRA

- Future East Garrison near Barloy Canyon Road
- Army previously investigated some portions
- ESCA will conduct additional investigations
- Collected data will refine the path forward
- Field investigations after the Final Work Plan
- Expect field investigation August 2010



Biological Monitoring

- All activities coordinated with Army to support the Habitat Management Plan & Biological Opinions
- Future East Garrison: Monitoring for California Tiger salamander breeding habitat
- Future East Garrison, Interim Action Ranges, Parker Flats: Survey sand gilia and Monterey spineflower
- Parker Flats and Seaside: Erosion control measures

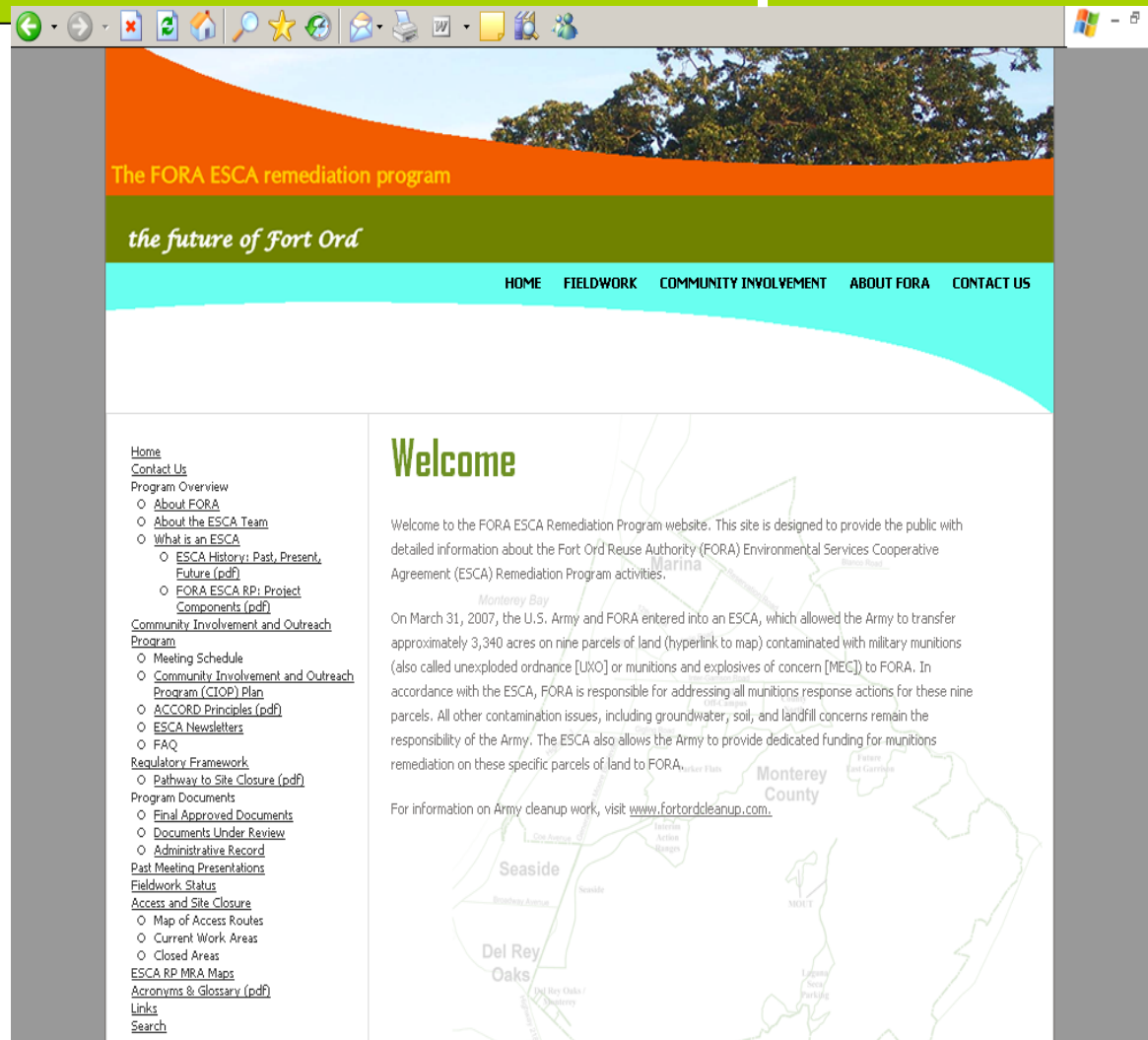
